**CAMDEN COUNTY INSURANCE COMMISSION
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF EXCESS INSURANCES FOR
DEPARTMENT OF POLICE SERVICES COUNTY OF CAMDEN**

WHEREAS, the Camden County Insurance Commission (hereinafter “the Commission”) is duly constituted as a joint insurance fund and is subject to certain requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law; and;

WHEREAS, the Commission has deemed it necessary and appropriate to obtain certain extraordinary and unspecifiable services for the Camden County Department of Police Services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Commission resolve to award an agreement for certain insurance coverages in accordance with N.J.S.A 40A:11-5 (l) (m) and has received a certification from the Commission Executive Director and/or Fund Underwriting Manager on the nature of such services and the due diligence efforts that were made to obtain the quotes; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following contract be awarded for the period of April 8, 2013 through January 1, 2014.




