WHEREAS, these contracts are awarded pursuant to a publicly advertised request for proposals and N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i) and in accordance with the Commission's Request For Proposal Policy; and

WHEREAS, the term of the contracts authorized herein shall commence on or about June 1, 2013 through May 31, 2014; now, therefore,
